

Prayer has a long history in America. From the arrival of the Mayflower, the founding of the earliest colonies, and through to today, presidents and leaders have called to set aside time to specifically observe and be devoted to prayer. Benjamin Franklin called on members of the Continental Congress to pray at the beginnings of their sessions. President George Washington began the tradition of calling for national days of prayer and fasting during key times when the country was in need. President Truman made the National Day of Prayer an annual observance, saying, “In times of national crisis when we are striving to strengthen the foundations of peace... we stand in special need of Divine Support.”



America continues to urgently need prayer – and the National Day of Prayer is a reminder of our calling to pray and put God first in our lives.
