July 4: 250th Anniversary of the Declaration of Independence

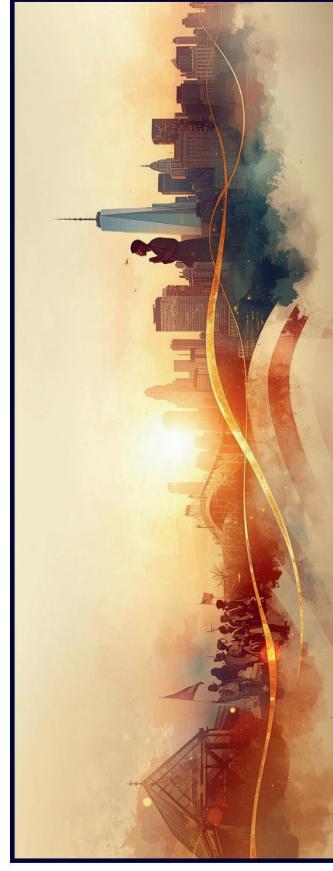

PRAYING WITH BIBLICAL CLARITY

The world is loud, but Truth is steady. We often pray from our "urgent" list, but Scripture invites us to pray from God's "eternal" heart. This shift moves us from the chaos of the world and headlines to the clarity of the Word, so that reactive thoughts transform into confident, biblical intercession.



Urgent Prayers vs. Eternal Prayers

Urgent prayers rise from the pressure of the moment: news alerts, deadlines, and anxieties. These matter to God, but they are not meant to be your anchor. Eternal prayers begin with who God is and what He has already spoken. Urgency may stir us to pray, but eternal perspective is what steadies us.

Pray from Scripture, Not Just with Scripture

Let God's Word rebuild your heart and reshape your requests. As you read, look for His character and listen for His priorities. Allow those eternal truths, not your temporary feelings, dictate what you ask, what you believe, and what you surrender.

Biblical Anchors Steady Prayer

Scripture is the solid ground beneath us when the world feels like it's falling away. God's sovereignty isn't an abstract theory; it is a historical reality that has outlasted every empire and sustained every generation. We don't pray to inform God of the news; we pray to align our hearts with His kingdom.

FAITHFUL THROUGH THE GENERATIONS

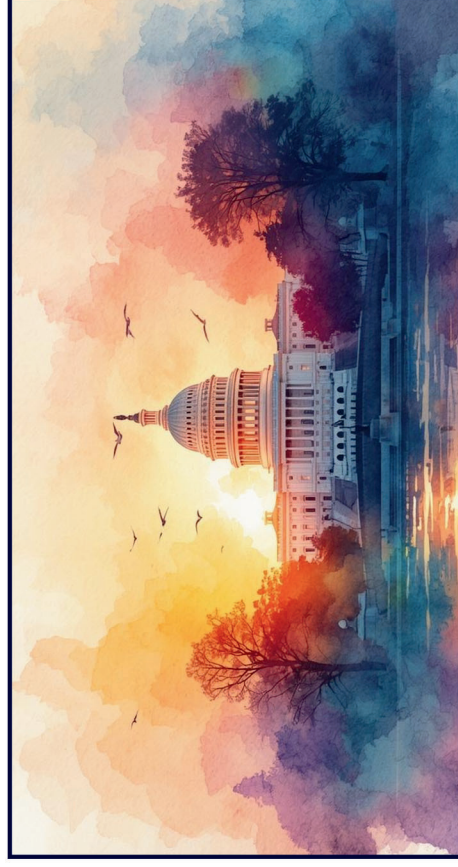
